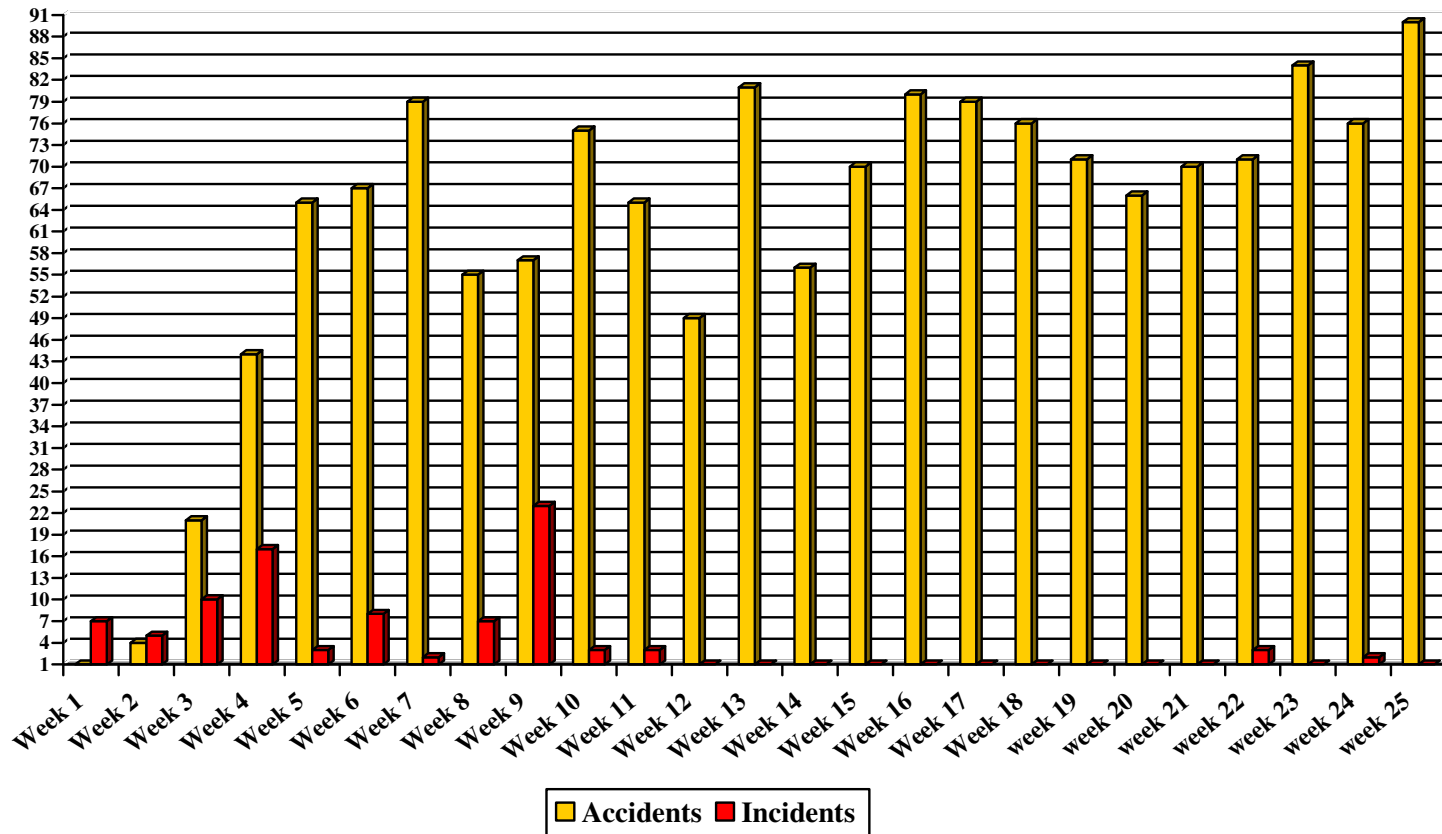

Weekly Accidents and Incidents Table



## **Week 1**

### **Accidents**

No accidents were reported for this first week of activities

### **Incidents**

- On 27 October 2007 2 unexploded mortar shells were found in the El-man settlement garbage
- On 28 October 2007 1 unexploded mortar shell and 1 F-1 hand grenade were found in the El-man settlement garbage
- On 29 October 2007 1 unexploded mortar shell was found in the El-man settlement garbage
- On 28 October 2007, in the district of Wadajir, 6 men in police uniform attacked the worksite and took by force 2 mobile phones - from waste site monitor, and the health worker. After their operation, they fled the area and have not been seen since.
- On 29 October 2007, in the district of Hodan, 2 armed men in police uniform confronted the work crew at gunpoint and forced a stoppage at the site for about 2 hours. There were accompanied by a woman who was claiming to be an IDP settlement leader; and she wanted to confirm that the 3 women who were selected from her settlement were in fact from her settlement; and were in fact the real women identified by name on the list. Finally, the matter was resolved by the district authorities amicably.

## **Week 2**

### **Accidents**

- One accident was reported in Hodan in the second week of activities (see incidents below).
- On the 4 of November 2007, a woman worker in the district of Bondhere was injured, after a thorn from a place they were clearing pierced her left hand. The health workers attended the injured worker and gave her proper medication.
- On 6 November 2007, in the district of Hamar- Jajab one worker got injured slightly while she hit herself with a spade on the right leg. She was giving medication.
- On the 8 November 2007, in the district of Shibis one worker lost her balance and fell to the ground as it was raining that day. She was slightly injured.

## **Incidents**

- On 4 November 2007, in the district of Hodan, there was a shootout between 2 free-lance militias and government police, not far from a worksite. Most of the workers ran and took cover. One lady worker, while running, hit her head on a pole. She was taken to Madina Hospital and got 5 stitches on the head. She is feeling well now, and is recovering from the incident
- On 4 November in the district of Karaan, one F-1 hand grenade was found at the worksite
- On 6 November, in the district of Hodan, a huge anti-tank shell was found at the worksite
- On the 7 November, in the district Hodan, one RPG round was found
- On the 8 November, one mortar shell (60 mm) was found in the district of Wardhigley

## **Week 3**

### **Accidents**

- On 10 November 2007, in the district of Bondhere, 1 lady suffered an injury in the front of her face after she incidentally hit herself with a tool she was working with. She was attended to by the site health worker and is okay.
- On 10 November 2007, in the district of Hamar-jajab, 2 people were slightly injured with the spades they were working with, and got injuries on their legs. They promptly received medical attention on site, and are okay.
- In the period between 10-14 November 2007, in the district of Hodan, 7 people sustained various injuries - mostly on the hands, during work at the site. They all received medical attention on site, and they are all okay.
- On 12 November 2007, in the district of Dharkeynley, 2 workers were injured - 1 in the hand, and the other on the right leg, after they were sliced by sharp objects that were hidden in the garbage. They immediately received medical attention by the site health worker, and they are okay.
- On 12 November 2007, in the district of Heliwaa, a worker accidentally hit his fellow worker with a spade on his right leg. A small area of the leg needed 2 stitches; and this was completed by the site health worker. The person is okay.
- On 14 November 2007, in the district of Shibis, 2 workers were slightly injured while working. They received medical attention on site and are okay.
- On 14 November 2007, in the district of Deynile, 5 workers were injured as they were cutting shrubs from worksite. Most of them were injured by thorns. The injuries were minor and were treated on site. All are okay.
- On 14 November 2007, in the district of Shingani, 1 lady hit one toe of her left leg with a stone. After the incident, the site health worker removed the nail of the toe that was cut. She immediately received all the proper medications and was put to rest that day.

## Incidents

- On 12 November, in the district of Hamar-jajab, a 40 mm round was discovered at the worksite and handed over to Sarandi Police Station in the district of Hamar-jajab by DDG and SAACID Somalia field staff together. The cartridge was an STM round according to the DDG personnel.
- On 14 November, the following UXOs were also found in Hamar-jajab District. They were also handed over to Sarandi Police Station in partnership with DDG.

## Week 4

### Accidents

- 2 minor accidents in Abdul-aziz District were reported
- 3 minor accidents in Bondhere District were reported
- 4 workers were pierced with thorns on their hands in Deynile District
- 5 minor accidents caused by tools were reported in Dharkeynley District
- 2 accidents caused by tools were reported in Hamar-weyne District
- 8 accidents caused by thorns and cactus were reported in Heliwaa District
- 6 minor accidents caused by tools and the spikes of cactus were reported in Hodan District
- 2 minor accidents caused by tools were reported in Karaan District
- 3 minor accidents were reported in Shingani District
- 2 minor accidents were reported in Waberi District
- 1 minor accident was reported in Wadajir District

## Incidents

- It was reported that the workers in Hamar-jajab District found 2 time-fuses that were not yet set; but were in excellent condition. They were taken to the local police station.
- 3 UXOs were recorded in Hamar-weyne District
  1. Rocket Propelled Grenade 7 round 1
  2. Rocket Propelled Grenade 2 round 1
  3. Anti-aircraft - 37 mm round 1
- 6 anti-tank mine fuses were discovered in the settlement and handed into local police in Karaan District
- In Warberri District, there were some interruptions when the government and Ethiopian forces that pass this road fired bullets indiscriminately causing panic, as they are afraid of landmines. Fortunately, no one has been injured when they do this action.
- 5 UXO incidents were recorded in Wardhigley District this week:

## **Incidents**

- In Deynile District, someone in a speeding car through a grenade at Ethiopian troops. This happened close to the current worksite. The Ethiopian responded with gunfire. This scared all the workers and the inhabitants in the IDP settlement.
- In Warberri District, not far from the worksite, a number of armed people in military uniform fired their weapons into the air, causing panic among the pedestrians in the area. All the workers had to lie down to avoid stray bullets.

### **Incidents**

- 1 UXO incident was recorded in Abdul-aziz District this week:
  1. 120 mm artillery round 1
- Bondhere District and settlement leaders had to intervene in one incident, when a lady who didn't pay much attention to the ongoing sanitation works, poured filthy water down from the 3rd floor of a building onto the workers. The workers were complaining that this was not the first time that water was thrown on them, and they would not tolerate such behaviour in the future.
- In Wardhigley District, a number of the workers were complaining from harassment from drug-addicted youths living in the area.

### Incidents

- In Dharkeynley District, there were a few hours of work stoppage when Ethiopians and TFG militiamen raided a nearby school looking for weapons
- There was a small brawl between the workers and the inhabitants of Alla-Magan 1 settlement in Karaan District, over the misbehaviour of some of the settlement dwellers. The matter was amicably solved by the district authority and settlement leaders.
- A large explosion in Karaan District just 200 meters from Alla-Magan 1 settlement targeted and killed a high profile government official. The whole area was cordoned by police thus causing few hours of work stoppage.
- The following UXOs were found in the garbage in Shibis District:

- As work was progressing well in the SIDAM settlement of Shingani District, one of the settlement dwellers attacked the supervisor and asked him to stop the work in the site. The District Commissioner went to the site and settled the matter and the work continued as planned.
- The following UXOs were found in the garbage in Shingani District:
 

1. 60 mm mortar round	2
2. F-1 hand grenade	1
3. Recoilless artillery round	1
4. Rifle bullets	3
- Disruptions occurred on a daily basis in Waberi District. Minibuses and other cars are lined not far from the settlement and police always come to disperse the people crowded in the area. Also in the worksite vicinity, glue sniffers occasionally fight each other and other civilians in the district. They are armed with knives and other sharp materials, interrupting the work regularly by threatening the workers.
- The security of Wadajir District was not good this week. When the workers loaded the last trip and sent it to the dumpsite, two youths came and asked the monitor to leave the area. The youths said that they were waiting for the work to finish, so that they could make an attack. When asked to give proof that they were serious, they simply lifted up their shirts and showed that they had loaded pistols and F-1 hand grenades. Without a second word the workers vacated the site. No attack was made after the workers left. SAACID was later told that they were after tax collectors that were operating in the area; but they did not appear as scheduled.
- In Wardhigley District, on one day, the truck was held by the Ethiopians for nearly one hour as the security of the area is very high and tense all the time.
- In Wardhigley District, 2 workers fought over who would use a bucket during the work. The matter was solved later amicably.

- The following UXO was found in the garbage in Hodan District:
  1. 60 mm mortar round 1
- Fighting in the district of Heliwaa (the Industrial Road) caused the landing of a number of mortar shells and straying bullets that caused panic amongst the Karaan workgroup, which led to a delay in the work.
- In the district of Waberi, the work team had half completed its work, when TFG police came and gave the IDP families in that compound notice that they were going to be evicted. The work team thus left for a new work site, with the job incomplete.

## **Incidents**

- It was reported in Deynile District that 2 men armed with pistols and hand grenades passed the worksite and threatened the monitor, claiming that he was working for the government. After some minutes of discussions with other co-workers, they were convinced that this activity had nothing to do with the TFG of insurgency. These guys were common criminals trying to extort cash. They eventually left empty-handed.
- In an incident this week in Karaan District, freelance militiamen attempted to take a cell phone from the health worker, but fortunately a police van appeared from the other side of the road and the militiamen immediately fled.
- After unknown militiamen shot dead one policeman in Waberi District, TFG police surrounded the IDP settlement where the workers were operating, and there work stoppages for a few hours. After they saw that all the workers are wearing reflective jackets they left.

### **Incidents**

- The security of Hawl-wadag was very dangerous. There was continued fierce fighting between the Ethiopian/TFG troops and anti-government forces in the district. Workers sometimes had to take cover as stray bullets landed in the worksite.
- In Karaan District, a group of insurgents attacked the district police station and all the workers ran for their safety. After the fighting died down, the workers resumed their work.
- In Waberi District, there was a big explosion instantly killing a police chief, and the whole area near the worksite was barricaded by government troops looking for a clue. The workers were not interfered with when the police saw their reflective jackets.
