## **Emergency IDP Settlement Rehabilitation Programme**

### **Week 14 Progress Report**

**11 – 17 April 2008**

#### **Summary**

The second phase *Emergency IDP Settlement Rehabilitation Programme* continued for a second week, and all work crews operated without constraint.

Although the overall security of the city of Mogadishu was a bit tense, that didn't hinder from all the workers to come to the worksite punctually.

SAACID staff, with the help of some district representatives and camp leaders, was continuously monitoring the attendance of the workers, and were advising site monitors to watch closely the loads of garbage of each truck, and that the truck was properly covered after being loaded.

Almost all of the IDP settlement populations are very happy with the recommencement of this programme, and the work is going well and without any serious disruptions so far.

Attendance of the workers at all the worksites was very good.

There were 56 accidents, no incidents and no UXOs recorded across all worksites this week.

### **Abdul-aziz District**

A total of 84 beneficiaries were working in the district.

The labourers were working at 2 camps - Beach and Markabka - where vast amounts of garbage have accumulated.

The garbage collection at Beach settlement took 3 days (from 12<sup>th</sup>-14 April), while Markabka settlement took another 3 days (15-17 April).

The local authority and camp leaders were very happy and welcomed the ongoing programme in the district.

The 1 truck that was contracted for the district completed its output of 36 loads as agreed.

5 minor accidents were reported in the district this week, and the health worker at the site treated the injured workers. They returned to work after being treated.

Attendance of the workers was very excellent.

No incidents were reported this week for this district.

### **Bondhere District**

A total of 42 beneficiaries were working in the district.

The labourers were working for a second week at Tawakal settlement.

The labourers killed a large snake that was hiding in the garbage, and the inhabitants of the camp were very happy, as they have seen it many times, but it had always escaped.

Large amounts of garbage have been removed from the settlement. The 1 truck that was contracted for the district completed its output of 36 loads as agreed.

No accidents or incidents were reported other than the snake that was killed.

Attendance of the workers was very good.

### **Deynile District**

The full quotas of 18 workers were working in the district.

They were still working at 77 settlement. The location is full of garbage and thorny shrubs. The 1 truck assigned to the district completed the agreed number of trips.

There were no incidents reported in this district this week, although contingents of Ethiopian army personnel were camping around the area.

4 people were slightly injured from spikes of cactus.

Attendance of the workers was very good.

### **Dharkeynley District**

The full quotas of 27 workers were working in the district.

They are working in the same settlement for a second week. Large amounts of garbage and other harmful materials were removed from the site. The 1 truck assigned to the district completed the agreed number of trips.

2 people were slightly injured by sharp objects in the garbage.

Attendance of the workers was very good.

The security was okay, and no incidents were recorded.

### **Hamar-jajab & Hawl-wadag Districts**

The full quota of 57 workers was working in the district.

The labourers were working at this settlement a second week. Large amounts of garbage have been removed from the settlement.

The 1 truck assigned to the district loaded its consignments as contracted.

3 workers sustained injuries during the course of the week.

Attendance of the workers and punctuality was reported as good.

No incidents were recorded in this district this week.

### **Hamar-weyne District**

The full quota of 84 workers was working in the district.

The labourers were working at this new settlement, where there was a large amount of garbage, empty plastic bags and cow dung.

The 1 truck assigned to the district loaded its consignments as contracted.

5 workers sustained injuries during the course of the week.

Attendance of the workers and punctuality is reported as good.

No incidents were recorded in this district this week.

## **Heliwaa District**

A total of 21 beneficiaries were working in the district.

The labourers were working for a second camp in the same settlement of Geed Timir, where a large amount of garbage and other harmful materials, like thorny cactus and trees have accumulated.

The workers removed a large amount of garbage and they sent it to a dumpsite.

The 1 truck that was contracted for the district completed its outputs 36 loads as agreed.

4 minor accidents caused by tools and cactus thorns were reported.

Attendance of the workers was very excellent.

No incidents were recorded in this district this week.

## **Hodan District**

The full quotas of 135 workers reported for work in the district of Hodan.

The workers have completed cleaning Sedex-burod, Towhid 1 and Tawakal settlements last week, and moved to 3 new large settlements: Liban Digfeer, Shabel and Barwaqo 1.

These settlements were full of garbage and thorny bushes.

There were some occasional work stoppages by TFG militias, who were escorting convoys of Ethiopian troops.

The 2 trucks assigned to the district loaded their consignments as contracted.

11 people were injured, with 3 seriously hurt by tool strikes, and they needed one day's rest.

Attendance of the workers was reported as good.

## **Karaan District**

A total of 69 beneficiaries were working in the district.

The labourers were working at Inji 2 settlement, where there was a large amount of garbage and other harmful materials.

The workers removed a large amount of garbage and they sent it to the dumpsite.

The District Commissioner, Mr. Abdullahi, and other local authorities and camp leaders, were very happy and welcomed the ongoing programme in the district.

The 1 truck that was contracted for the district completed its outputs 36 loads as agreed.

5 workers sustained injuries that were caused by tools.

The security of the site and the district at large was good, and no incidents were recorded in the district this week.

Attendance of the workers was very good.

### **Shibis District**

A total of 33 beneficiaries were working in the district.

The labourers were working for the second week in a row at Shibis School settlement.

The labourers removed large amounts of garbage from the camp.

The 1 truck that was contracted for the district completed its outputs 36 loads as agreed.

3 workers were injured by thorny cactus.

Attendance of the workers was very good.

The security of the worksite was okay, and no incidents were recorded.

### **Shingani District**

A total of 42 beneficiaries were working in the district.

The labourers were working for the second week in a row at same site that they were working last week - Aspimo settlement.

The labourers have removed large amounts of garbage and discarded and broken bottles from the settlement.

The 1 truck that was contracted for the district completed its outputs 36 loads as agreed.

4 workers were injured caused by sharp objects.

Attendance of the workers was very good.

The security of the worksite was okay, and no incidents were recorded.

### **Waberi District**

The full quota of 48 workers was working in the district.

The labourers were working at the same settlement for a second week in a row. Large amounts of garbage have been removed from the settlement.

The 1 truck assigned to the district loaded its consignments as contracted.

5 workers sustained slight injuries during the course of the week.

Attendance of the workers and punctuality is reported as good.

No incidents were recorded in this district this week.

### **Wadajir District**

The full quotas of 54 workers were working in the district.

They were working on the same Darman settlement for the second week in a row. Workers have removed large amounts of smelly garbage and other harmful materials.

The 1 truck assigned to the district completed the agreed number of trips.

3 people were slightly injured by sharp objects in the garbage.

Attendance of the workers was very good.

The security of the area was good, and no incidents were recorded.

### **Wardhigley District**

A total of 42 beneficiaries were working in the district.

The labourers were working at the new settlement of Asha Elmi, where there was a vast amount of garbage that has accumulated over a period of time.

The 1 truck that was contracted for the district completed its outputs 36 loads as agreed.

2 workers were injured caused by thorny cactus.

Attendance of the workers was very good.

The security of the worksite was very tense since the settlement was not very far from the Presidential Place. No incidents were recorded at the worksite though.

### **Yaqshid District**

A total of 69 beneficiaries were working in the district.

The labourers were working for the second week in the same settlement of Abtow, where there was large amount of garbage and other harmful materials like thorny cactus and trees that had accumulated.

The District Commissioner visited and encouraged the workers to benefit from this valuable opportunity for them, and for the district of Yaqshid at large.

The workers removed large amount of garbage and they sent it to a dumpsite. The 1 truck that was contracted for the district completed its outputs 36 loads as agreed.

7 workers sustained injuries that were caused by tools and cactus thorns were reported.

The security of the area was tense, although no incidents were recorded this week.
