## Emergency IDP Settlement Rehabilitation Programme

### Weeks 18 Progress Report

9-15 May 2008

#### Summary

The 18<sup>th</sup> week of the *Emergency IDP Settlement Rehabilitation Programme* progressed well in all the 16 districts of Mogadishu. Though there have been obvious insecurity problems throughout the city, it has been the roadblocks and security checks that have caused most problems in constraining optimal effectiveness of the programme.

Districts that were weighed down by the ongoing skirmishes between the TFG-backed militias and Ethiopian forces and opposition insurgents included Heliwaa, some sectors of Yaqshid, some sectors of Hodan, Hawl-wadag and Deynile. Overall, the programme has been able to operate without constraint in all the 16 district sites.

SAACID key staff continuously monitored and visited worksites to encourage and push the workers and district representative to work hard and meet the programme planned outputs.

SAACID key programme staff met with the SAACID administration section to discuss the possibility of putting together some district's human resources and their trucks in removing piles of garbage in certain settlements to meet the programme's planned outputs and the timely cleaning of all targeted settlements. It was agreed to call a meeting with all the worksite monitors on 20 May to discuss the issue of teaming certain districts.

In the meantime, since the district of Shibis has successfully finished all of its 11 settlements; and it was directed that they should immediately join forces with Karaan, who have many settlements with huge amounts of garbage.

There were 76 accidents and no incidents reported across all worksites this week.

Some 22,032 tonnes of garbage have not been removed from IDP settlements through 6 weeks of the second phase of the *Emergency IDP Settlement Rehabilitation Programme*.

### **Abdul-aziz District**

The full quota of 84 workers was working in the district this week.

The district targeted 3 settlements: the district authority and the settlement leaders, because of the vast amounts of garbage that accumulated in the settlements for a long time, selected Xuriyo, Ex-Wardhigley and Ciraaq.

The district workers were able to clean each settlement for a period of 2 days.

The workers sent 36 loads of garbage to the dumpsite this week.

The 1 truck assigned to the district loaded its consignments as contracted.

No incidents were reported in this district this week.

It was reported that 6 workers were injured at the work sites this week.

Attendance of the workers and punctuality is reported as good.

### **Bondhere District**

The full quota of 42 workers was working in the district this week.

They moved to 2 new sites, called Dhulbixinta and Kalturada Fransiiska settlements, where there were large amount of garbage and other harmful materials.

The district succeeded in cleaning all garbage, and sending 36 loads of garbage to the dumpsite.

The 1 truck assigned to the district loaded its consignments as contracted.

3 people were slightly injured during the course of the week.

Attendance of the workers was very good.

There were no incidents reported in this district this week.

### **Deynile District**

The full quota of 18 workers was working in the district this week.

This 18<sup>th</sup> week of activities the workers were operation at 2 sites: Dhaba Xaadle and Tiida. Both settlements were full of garbage, harm full materials and thorny bushes.

The district workers removed large amounts of garbage and sent to the dumpsites.

The Ethiopian troops were attacked not far from worksite on 2 occasions instances. They surrounded the workers, but when they found the uniform and the tools, plus the truck they were loading, they left.

5 people were injured at the worksites this week.

Attendance of the workers was good.

### **Dharkeynley**

The full quota of 27 workers was working in the district this week.

The targeted settlement was called Sheeq Yuusuf, and there were vast amounts of garbage that had accumulated in the settlements for a long time.

The district workers were able to clean the settlement, and they removed 36 loads of garbage and sent it to the dumpsite this week.

The 1 truck assigned to the district loaded its consignments as contracted.

No incidents were reported in this district this week.

6 workers were injured in this district this week.

Attendance of the workers and punctuality is reported as good.

### **Hamar-jajab and Hawl-wadag Districts**

The full quotas of 57 workers were working in the district this week.

This week the security of the district was not good, and there were attacks on government militias by the insurgency, causing disruptions to transportation in the district.

The workers were operating at a new settlement - Osman A. Roble - that is full of garbage and debris from demolished buildings.

The 1 truck assigned to the district loaded its consignments as contracted.

5 workers suffered minor injuries in this district this week.

No incidents were reported in this district this week.

Attendance of the workers was good.

### **Hamar-weyne District**

The full quota of 39 workers was working in the district of Hamar-weyne this week.

This 18<sup>th</sup> week of *Emergency IDP Settlement Rehabilitation Programme* the district moved to 2 new settlements called: Buulo-Batera and Via Ejito settlements. Both settlements were full of garbage, animal bones.

The workers removed large amounts of garbage, and sent 36 loads to the dumpsite.

The 1 truck assigned to the district loaded its consignments as contracted.

No incidents were reported in this district this week.

7 workers were slightly injured in this district this week.

Attendance of the workers was good.

### **Heliwaa District**

The full quota of 21 workers was working in the district of Heliwaa this week.

The workers were this week operating at Faras Oliyo settlement. The settlement is located in the north sector of the district, and home for large number of displaced people that have been affected by continuous conflict between the Ethiopians and the armed insurgency.

There were vast amounts of garbage in the settlement, and due to the recent rains in the city, the garbage become wet and stinky.

The workers sent 36 loads of garbage to the dumpsite.

The 1 truck assigned to the district completed the number of loads required.

5 workers were injured in this district this week.

No major incident was reported in this district this week.

Attendance of the workers is very good.

### **Hodan District**

The full quota of 135 workers reported for work in the district of Hodan.

This 18<sup>th</sup> week of the *Emergency IDP Settlement Rehabilitation Programme* the district moved to 3 new settlements – Kuuriya, Ceel-waaq and Qasabka. All the targeted settlements were covered with large amounts of garbage and other harmful materials.

The district workers removed large amounts of garbage from each settlement, and sent 72 loads of garbage to the dumpsite.

The security of the district was very dangerous, as there attacks from insurgency groups occurred on the AMISOM units, and the AMISOM troops retaliated with indiscriminate heavy shelling. There were also increased roadblocks and security checks.

The 2 trucks assigned to the district loaded their consignments as contracted.

9 people were slightly injured in the district this week.

No incidents were reported this week in this district.

Attendance of the workers was very good.

### **Karaan and Shibis District**

The full quotas of 102 workers were now operating in the district.

Karaan district workers were joined by Shibis workers, and both teams moved to work in 3 new settlements, where there was a vast amount of garbage that was piled up for decades.

As the number of the human resources was increased, the output this week reached 72 loads of garbage for the district of Karaan, thus improving the sanitation of all the settlements that were cleaned.

The 2 trucks assigned to the district loaded its consignments as contracted.

8 workers were injured, mostly sharp objects in the garbage.

No incidents were reported in this district this week.

Attendance of the workers is reported as good.

### **Shingani District**

The full quota of 42 workers was working in the district this week.

Workers of the district this 18<sup>th</sup> week of the *Emergency IDP Settlement Rehabilitation Programme* moved to a new settlement called Buraale.

The targeted place was full of garbage, debris and other discarded materials.

Workers succeeded in removing 36 loads of garbage from the site.

The 1 truck assigned to the district loaded its consignments as contracted.

4 workers were slightly injured in this district this week.

No incidents were reported in this district this week.

Attendance of the workers and punctuality was reported as good.

### **Waberi District**

The full quota of 48 workers was working in the district this week.

This week the workers of the district were operating in at new site called Otto-Otto Settlement, where there were large amounts of garbage and other harmful materials that have accumulated over the years.

The settlement leaders and representatives from the district authority visited the worksite and encouraged the workers to increase work output in order to meet deadlines.

The 1 truck assigned to the district completed the agreed number of trips.

4 people were injured in this district this week.

No incidents were reported in this district this week.

Attendance of the workers was very good.

### **Wadajir District**

The full quota of 54 workers was operating at this new settlement this week.

The settlement was full of garbage that has accumulated for a long period.

The 1 truck assigned to the district completed the number of loads required.

5 accidents caused by tools were reported in this district this week.

No incidents were reported in this district this week.

Attendance of the workers was reported as very good.

### **Wardhigley District**

The full quotas of 42 workers were operating in the district this week.

The workers moved to a new site called Dabille, which was covered by vast amounts of garbage and other harmful materials in the settlement.

Workers removed vast amounts of garbage and sent 36 loads of garbage to the dumpsite.

The 1 truck assigned to the district loaded its consignments as contracted.

3 injuries were reported in the district this week.

No incidents were reported in this district this week.

Attendance of the workers and punctuality was reported as good.

### **Yaqshid District**

The full quota of 69 workers started working at a new settlement.

The new settlement is full of garbage, cactus and other thorny scattered shrubs.

The security of the district has not improved and sporadic fighting and roadblocks were still active in everywhere of the district.

The workers removed 36 loads of garbage and sent to the dumpsite.

No incidents were reported in this district this week.

The 1 truck assigned to the district loaded its consignments as contracted.

6 workers were slightly injured in this district this week.

Attendance of the workers was reported as good.
