## EMERGENCY IDP SETTLEMENT REHABILITATION PROGRAMME

### Week 22 Progress Report

6-12 June 2008

#### Summary

The *Emergency IDP Settlement Rehabilitation Programme* progressed well in all the 16 districts of Mogadishu in week 22 of the programme.

Almost all the targeted settlements for the second phase are all cleaned and most of the IDP communities in the targeted settlements where the sanitation work is nearly accomplished and ending have experienced high levels of improvement in terms of the overall sanitation in their settlements and the amount of garbage collected for the IDPs.

Appreciations and complementing statements from the district authorities, prominent Mogadishu residents and IDP settlement leaders have been echoing throughout the city for the past few days. People of all walks agreed that SAACID has in fact accomplished a lot in involving IDP people in its programming and giving them the highest priority.

During the course of this week there were no improvements in the security situation in Mogadishu City as government /Ethiopian forces and the anti-government insurgents continued fierce fighting, causing heavy casualties on the population in the city.

Attendance of the workers at all the worksites was excellent in this third week of activities.

There were 71 accidents and 3 incidents reported across all worksites this week.

Some 36,720 tonnes of garbage have not been removed from IDP settlements through 7 weeks of the second phase of the *Emergency IDP Settlement Rehabilitation Programme*.

### **Abdul-aziz District**

The full quota of 84 workers was working in the district this week. The targeted settlement was still full of garbage and other harmful materials that were dumped inside the settlement. To speed up work in the settlement the district officials, with support from IDP settlement committees, spent some time monitoring the progress of the work in the settlement.

The 1 truck assigned to the district loaded its consignments as contracted.

No incidents were reported in this district this week.

There were 8 workers that sustained minor injuries in the district this week.

Attendance of the workers was reported as good.

### **Deynile District**

The full quota of 18 workers reported for work in the district this week. The workers were operating at a new settlement where there were large amounts of garbage, cactus and thorny trees.

This week the security of the district was unsafe, as fierce fighting between the Ethiopians and government troops and the insurgency spread through the whole area of Deynile.

The 1 truck assigned to the district completed the agreed number of trips.

There were 4 workers who were injured caused by thorns in the district this week.

Attendance of the workers was very good.

### **Dharkeynley and Wadajir Districts**

The full quota of 81 workers from the districts of Dharkeynley and Wadajir were operating in the district of Dharkeynley this week. Both district workers moved to a new settlement where there were large amounts of garbage and other harmful materials.

72 loads of garbage and other discarded materials were sent to dumpsite this week.

No incidents were reported in this district this week.

There were 11 workers that suffered injuries in the district this week.

Attendance of the workers was very good.

### **Hawl-wadag and Wardhigley Districts**

The full quota of 75 workers was working in the district of Hawl-wadag this week. The targeted settlement was full of garbage and other harmful materials.

The security of area was very dangerous. There was continued fierce fighting between the Ethiopian/TFG troops and anti-government forces in the district. Workers sometimes had to take a cover as stray bullets landed in the worksite.

The 1 truck assigned to the district loaded its consignments as contracted.

There were 8 workers that suffered minor injuries in the district this week.

Attendance of the workers and their punctuality was reported as good.

### **Hamar-weyne and Bondhere Districts**

The full quota of 81 workers was working in the district of Hamar-weyne this week. As the sanitation programme is nearly ending, the district workers were speeding up and have maximized their workforce in doing their best.

The targeted settlement was full of garbage that had accumulated for the past 17 years.

The 2 trucks assigned to the district loaded their consignments as contracted.

No incidents were reported in this district this week.

There were 5 workers injured in the district this week

Attendance of the workers was reported as good.

### **Heliwaa District**

The full quota of 21 workers was working in the district of Heliwaa this week. The workers were operating in a settlement called Buur-Bisharo, where there were vast amounts of garbage and other harmful materials.

This week anti-government forces attacked government positions causing instability in the district for 2 days. This caused significant disruptions for those 2 days.

The 1 truck assigned to the district completed the number of loads required.

There were 4 workers injured in the district this week.

Attendance of the workers was reported as very good.

### **Hodan District**

The full quota of 135 workers reported for work in the district of Hodan this week. This week the workers moved to 2 new settlements that were full of garbage and other harmful materials.

The workers succeeded in removing 72 loads of garbage from the targeted settlements.

No incidents were reported in this district this week.

There were 6 people injured in the district this week.

Attendance of the workers was reported as good.

### **Karaan and Shibis Districts**

The full quota of 102 workers was operating in the district this week. The targeted settlement was full of garbage and other harmful materials that were piled up for a decades. The workers removed vast amounts of garbage and send it to the dumpsite.

A group of insurgents attacked the district police station and all the workers ran for their safety. After the fighting died down, the workers resumed their work.

The 2 trucks that were contracted for the district completed their output of 72 loads as agreed.

There were 7 workers slightly injured in the district this week

Attendance of the workers is reported as good.

### **Shingani District**

The full quota of 42 workers was working in the district this week. The targeted settlement was Fiisha-Baraa and was full of garbage and other harmful materials that were piled inside the settlement for a very long time.

The workers removed 36 loads to the dumpsite.

The 1 truck assigned to the district loaded its consignments as contracted.

There were 5 workers slightly injured in the district this week.

No incidents were reported in this district this week.

Attendance of the workers and punctuality was reported as good.

### **Waberi and Hamar-jajab Districts**

The full quota of 72 workers from both Waberi and Hamar-jajab districts were working in the district of Waberi this week. Both districts, who share a long border, were operating at Wadatal settlement, where there were large amounts of garbage that has accumulated over long period.

There was a big explosion instantly killing a police chief, and the whole area near the worksite was barricaded by government troops looking for a clue. The workers were not interfered with when the police saw their reflective jackets.

The 2 trucks assigned to the district completed their agreed number of trips.

There were 7 district workers injured this week.

Attendance of the workers was very good.

### **Yaqshid District**

The full quota of 69 workers was operating in the district this week. The selected settlement was full of garbage, cactus and other thorny scattered shrubs.

The security of the district this week was very tense, and a new wave of IDPs was seen moving to safer areas in other districts.

The 1 truck assigned to the district loaded its consignments as contracted.

There were 6 workers were slightly injured in the district this week.

No incidents were reported in this district this week.

Attendance of the workers was reported as good.
