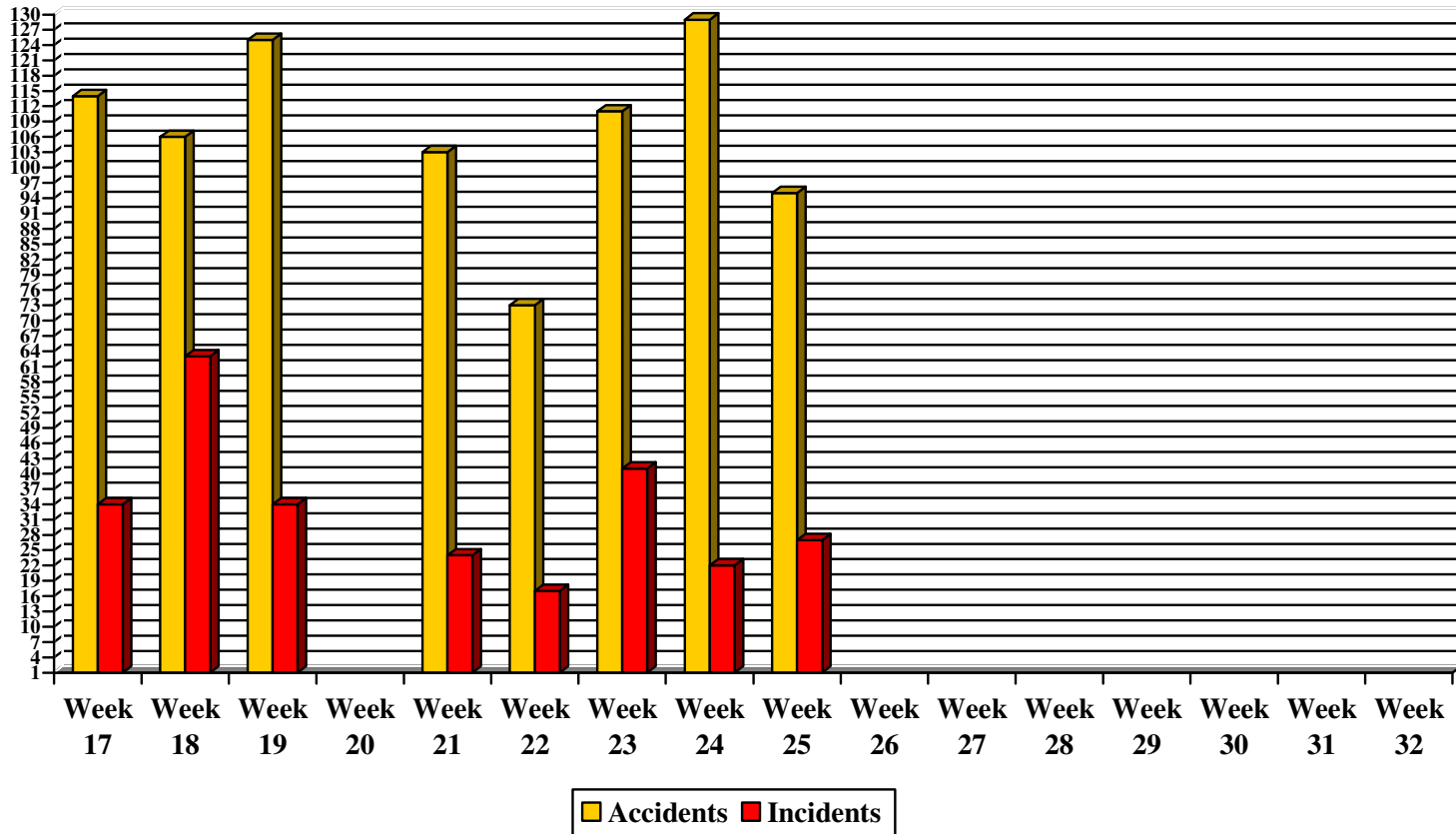

Weekly Accidents and Incidents Table



Week 17

Accidents

- In Abdul-aziz District, a total of 6 people were injured during the week
- In Deynile District, a total of 7 people sustained different injuries caused by different working tools and thorn threes
- In Dharkeynley District, 5 people sustained slight injuries from the working tools and hidden iron scrap
- In Hamar-jajab District, 8 people were injured this week
- In Hamar-weyne District, a total of 11 people sustained injuries while they cleaned a huge garbage deposit near the Indian Ocean beach
- In Hawl-wadag District, 9 people fainted while they removing the solid garbage
- In Hodan District, 3 of the workers drank contaminated water and got diarrhoea and the site nurse provided an ORS solution. Six other people sustained injuries while they were cleaning the garbage.
- In Heliwaa District, a total of 13 people got various problems from the garbage - like skin rashes, vomiting, nausea and skin scratching
- In Karaan District, 2 of the workers were hit by minibus' while they were busy cleaning the street
- In Shingani District, 9 people sustained injuries during the week
- In Shibis District, unknown objects that were hidden in the garbage injured 5 people
- In Warberi District, a total of 8 people sustained injuries this week
- In Wadajir District, 5 people recorded injuries in this district this week
- In Yaqshid District, 5 people were injured during the week
- In the Bermuda enclave, 12 people sustained injuries while they cut thorn trees and cactus that have accumulated in the area for the past 16 years

Incidents

- In Abdul-aziz District, 2 shells of Zeka-U (Russian type) – but without their shell casing - were unearthed in the garbage
- In Deynile District, the workers found 6 used dhishike shells buried at edge of the worksite
- In Dharkeynley District, 2 rust knives were found in the garbage while the workers were cleaning the site
- In Dharkeynley District, 2 of the workers had a row inspired by clan affiliation. The district administrator and site monitors resolved the misunderstanding.
- In Hamar-jajab District, the workers found 3 shells from a Zuu anti-aircraft gun in the garbage
- In Hawl-wadag District, 2 big shells were found in the garbage
- In Hodan District, the workers found 7 corroded shells of various types
- In Heliwaa District, 2 hand grenades were unearthed from the garbage and taken by UIC militiamen

- In Shingani District, the workers found the bones of a human in the garbage. The district administrators, with the help of site monitors re-buried the bones in a far place.
- In Warberri District, 2 rusted shells and 10 bullets were unearthed from the garbage
- In Warberri District, 1 of the trucks collided while speeding fast to the Halane dumpsite in the area of K4
- In Wadajir District, 1 of the workers was hit by private car that wanted to pass the crowded people and the workers yelled and gave the information to UIC militiamen
- In Wardhigley District, 3 hand grenades were found in the garbage and kept in a safe place near the site
- In the Bermuda enclave, the workers found 1 bazooka shell and it was taken by local UIC militiamen
- At Keysaney dumpsite, 1 of the dumpsite monitors for the Keysaney dumpsite was attacked by people that were trying to extort money from SAACID. They beat him badly and took all his papers and reporting notes. SAACID went to the site to solve the problem, because there are ongoing problems with trucks and their interest in following the agreed contract properly.

Week 18

Accidents

- A total of 7 people were injured in Abdul-aziz District this week
- A total of 8 people were slightly injured in Bondhere District this week
- Five workers were injured in Deynile District this week
- Five workers received injures in Dharkeynley District this week
- A total of 12 people sustained various slight injures in Hamar-jajab District this week
- A total of 5 people received slight injures in Hamar-weyne District this week
- A total of 7 people received slight injures while cleaning the garbage this week in Hawl-wadag District
- A total of 4 people were injured in this district this week in Hodan District
- A total of 6 people received slight injures in this district this week in Heliwaa District
- A total of 8 people were injured in Karaan District this week
- Six people were injured in Shingani District this week
- A total of 4 people sustained different injuries in Shibis District this week
- A total of 2 women and 1 man from Shibis District recorded positive for TB at SAACID's TB Clinic in Karaan District
- A total of 4 people sustained slight injuries in Warberri District this week
- Nine people sustained slight injures in Wadajir District this week
- Six people sustained injures in Wardhigley District this week
- A total of 7 people sustained injures in Yaqshid District this week

- Nine people sustained slight injuries from cutting cactus and thorn trees this week in the Bermuda enclave

Incidents

- The Abdul-aziz district leaders had to deal with harassment from the local UIC. The local UIC is demanding that the district pay for UIC security. The local district leaders have refused and the problem is outstanding.
- Two unexploded shells (D-30) were unearthed from the garbage in Bondhere District
- In Dharkeynley District, the workers found 3 hand grenades in the garbage
- The workers of Hamar-jajab District found 2 shells of 106 mm type
- Three shells of Bazooka No. 2 type were unearthed from the garbage in Hamar-weyne District
- The workers found 2 of 85 mm shells in the garbage in Hawl-wadag District
- An incident occurred in Hodan District when 2 of the workers clashed over clan-based insults. UIC militiamen put them in jail for 1 day
- In Heliwaa District, the workers found 3 unexploded mortars and 2 hand grenades in the garbage
- The workers found 3 hand grenades in the garbage in Karaan District
- Three shells (Bazooka - 2 or 'Baaruud') were found in the garbage in Shingani District
- The workers found 12 AK-47 rounds in the garbage in Warberi District
- Two 85 mm shells were unearthed from the garbage in Wadajir District
- The workers found 23 unexploded RPG rounds in the garbage in Wardhigley District
- The workers found 12 shells in the garbage in Yaqshid District
- The workers found 3 mortars in the garbage in the Bermuda enclave

Week 19

Accidents

- 16 people from the Abdul-aziz/Karaan grouping were injured this week
- 18 people from the Bondhere/Shibis grouping were injured this week
- 21 people from the Deynile/Wardhigley grouping were injured this week
- 14 people from the Dharkeynley/Wadajir grouping were injured this week
- 13 people from the Shingani/Hamar-weyne grouping were injured this week
- 16 people from the Hawl-wadag/Hodan grouping were injured this week
- 15 people from the Heliwaa/Yaqshid grouping were injured this week
- 12 people from the Warberi/Hamar-jajab grouping were injured this week

- A total of 9 people from the Bermuda enclave were injured during the week

Incidents

- The site monitors from the Abdul-aziz/Karaan grouping reported that the workers found 2 bazooka shells in the garbage
- The site monitors from the Bondhere/Shibis grouping reported that the workers found 2 shells in the garbage
- The site monitors of the Deynile/Wardhigley grouping reported that the workers found 4 rusted hand grenades without detonators
- The site monitors from the Dharkeynley & Wadajir Districts grouping reported that the workers found 12 Zoo-20 shells in the garbage
- Two freelance militia groups were fighting at the Shingani/Hamar-weyne grouping worksite, and shooting completely stopped work for half an hour and the workers had to hide in concrete buildings in the area. One of the militiamen was wounded in the conflict.
- The workers from the Shingani/Hamar-weyne grouping unearthed 6 UXOs: 3 hand grenades, 1 bazooka shell, 1 Dheshike shell and some G3 ammunition
- The Hawl-wadag/Hodan grouping met chaos from aggressive people who threw stones and burnt tires. They were protesting the entry of Ethiopian troops into the city. Four people were injured during chaos.
- The workers of the Hawl-wadag/Hodan grouping found 30-40 rounds of ammunition – plus 2 RPG rounds
- The workers of the Warberi/Hamar-jajab grouping found 2 shells of an 85 mm gun type
- After the collapse of the UIC in Mogadishu, many roadblocks have been created on the routes to the 3 dumpsites. Truck drivers have complained that the militiamen are extorting unreasonable amounts from the truck drivers for safe passage.

Work suspended because of endemic insecurity in Mogadishu City

Week 21

Accidents

- 8 people from the Abdul-aziz/Karaan grouping were injured this week
- 12 people from the Bondhere/Shibis grouping were injured this week
- 14 people from the Deynile/Wardhigley grouping were injured this week
- 12 people from the Dharkeynley/Wadajir grouping were injured this week
- 15 people from the Shingani/Hamar-weyne grouping were injured this week
- 13 people from the Hawl-wadag/Hodan grouping were injured this week

- 10 people from the Heliwaa/Yaqshid grouping were injured this week
- 12 people from the Warberi/Hamar-jajab grouping were injured this week
- 7 people from the Bermuda enclave were injured this week

Incidents

- The workers from the Abdul-aziz/Karaan grouping found 2 rusted hand grenades of a Russian type
- The workers from the Bondhere/Shibis grouping found 5 rounds of AK-47 ammunition in the garbage
- The workers from the Dharkeynley/Wadajir grouping found 6 shells of an 85 mm gun type (the Somali nick-name is Jeep) used during the confrontation between the warlord Abdi Qeybdiid and the Union of Islamic Courts (UIC)
- The site monitors from the Shingani/Hamar-weyne grouping reported that they received 11 rusted bullet rounds and 2 RPG rounds that were hidden in the garbage
- One of the workers from the Hawl-wadag/Hodan grouping, who had drunk a local beverage, fought with his fellow workers and attacked them with a spade and wounded 2 of them. The drunk was jailed by the local district police and released when the DC and the drunk's family solved the problem.
- The workers from the Heliwaa/Yaqshid grouping found 6 hand grenades made in Italy in late 40s
- The site supervisors from the Warberi/Hamar-jajab grouping reported that they found 4 corroded 120 mm mortar shells in the garbage
- The workers of the Bermuda enclave found 12 rounds off G-3 and AK-47 in the garbage

Week 22

Accidents

- 8 people from the Abdul-aziz/Karaan grouping were injured this week
- 9 people from the Bondhere/Shibis grouping were injured this week
- 12 people from the Deynile/Wardhigley grouping were injured this week
- 13 people from the Dharkeynley/Wadajir grouping were injured this week
- 6 people from the Shingani/Hamar-weyne grouping were injured this week
- 7 people from the Hawl-wadag/Hodan grouping were injured this week
- 8 people from the Heliwaa/Yaqshid grouping were injured this week
- 4 people from the Warberi/Hamar-jajab grouping were injured this week
- 6 people from the Bermuda enclave were injured this week

Incidents

- The Abdul-aziz/Karaan grouping found 3 anti-tank shells
- The Deynile/Wardhigley grouping found 1 bazooka shell and many rusted AK 47 bullets
- The Dharkeynley/Wadajir grouping found 3 rusted shells
- The Shingani/Hamar-weyne grouping received a letter threatening to kill them if they continued to work at their current worksite in support of the TFG
- The Hawl-wadag/Hodan grouping unearthed a big tank shell
- The site monitors of the Heliwaa/Yaqshid grouping reported that militiamen scattered papers that warned the workers to leave the area or they would be attacked for supporting the TFG. The district leaders and workers did not consider the threats serious at this point and continued to work at the site.
- The Warberi/Hamar-jajab grouping found 3 rusted hand grenades of USSR origin
- The Warberi/Hamar-jajab grouping received a threatening letter from the Mayor and his assistants – demanding the immediate stoppage of the programme in their districts. SAACID was asked to intervene in the issue.
- The workers of the Bermuda enclave found 12 rusted M-16 bullets
- Many new checkpoints have sprung up in the city, and all are extorting money from passing traffic. All the truck drivers and contractors are complaining of the significant increase in insecurity; and the significant increase in cost in delivering refuse to the dumpsites.

Week 23

Accidents

- 19 people from the Abdul-aziz/Karaan grouping were injured this week
- 17 people from the Bondhere/Shibis grouping were injured this week
- 16 people from the Deynile/Wardhigley grouping were injured this week
- 14 people from the Dharkeynley/Wadajir grouping were injured this week
- 13 people from the Shingani/Hamar-weyne grouping were injured this week
- 3 people from the Hawl-wadag/Hodan grouping were injured this week
- 10 people from the Heliwaa/Yaqshid grouping were injured this week
- 13 people from the Warberi/Hamar-jajab grouping were injured this week
- 8 people from the Bermuda enclave were injured this week

Incidents

- The Abdul-aziz/Karaan grouping found 13 rusted bullets from a variety of small arms – including G3, AK 47 and M16
- In the Deynile/Wardhigley grouping, an armed man contacted the workers ordering them to stop operations. The workers immediately sensed that the man was not alone and had some other associates hiding behind a nearby wall. The guy asked the workers: ‘where are the monitors of SAACID’? The workers suspected that the man had bad intentions and hid the identity of the monitors. Even some of the monitors wore the reflective jackets of the workers for cover. The workers immediately sent word to the local district authority. The DC and his deputies came to the site and the man and his colleagues left the place hastily.
- The Dharkeynley/Wadajir grouping found 4 bazooka shells and 7 mortar rounds
- The Shingani/Hamar-weyne grouping was involved in a brawl with local neighbourhood youth. There is a football playground for the youth of the neighbourhood where the workers were operating. On 1 occasion, the youth playing football at the field and the workers were involved in a brawl. A ball was kicked by one of the players and hit a woman worker. This was the cause detonating the brawl. The workers used the working tools as weapons for defence. The monitors contacted the one of the leaders of the youth vigilante group, known as “Ciidanka Madaniga”. The group leaders succeeded in appeasing the brawl.
- Three men and 3 women from the Shingani/Hamar-weyne grouping married this week
- The Heliwaa/Yaqshid grouping unearthed different types of unexploded shells - 3 bazooka, 7 antiaircraft shells and 4 hand grenades
- The Warberi/Hamar-jajab grouping received threatening letters that were scattered in the area, ordering them to leave the area, or they would meet grave difficulties. SAACID and the 2 DCs immediately ordered the workers to move to another site. The incident was reported to the TFG. After intensive investigations, the TFG militia arrested the 5 militia who scattered the threatening letter.
- The Warberi/Hamar-jajab grouping found 3 anti-aircraft shells, 2 bazooka shells and 5 AK 47 bullets
- The Warberi/Hamar-jajab grouping received a threatening letter from the Mayor and his assistants – demanding the immediate stoppage of the programme in their districts. SAACID was asked to intervene in the issue.
- The workers of the Bermuda enclave found 15 rusted G3 bullets and 2 RPG rockets
- The truck owners continue to encounter difficulties because the ever increasing number of roadblocks forcibly extorting money. The trucks are countering by trying to use side roads. Four of the trucks have had their mobiles taken at these roadblocks. The majority of the trucks dump the collected waste in Keysaney dumpsite because of the increasing insecurity.

Week 24

Accidents

- 12 people from the Abdul-aziz/Karaan grouping were injured this week
- 14 people from the Bondhere/Shibis grouping were injured this week
- 9 people from the Deynile/Wardhigley grouping were injured this week

- 14 people from the Dharkeynley/Wadajir grouping were injured this week
- 18 people from the Shingani/Hamar-weyne grouping were injured this week
- 13 people from the Hawl-wadag/Hodan grouping were injured this week
- 20 people from the Heliwaa/Yaqshid grouping were injured this week
- 15 people from the Warberi/Hamar-jajab grouping were injured this week
- 14 people from the Bermuda enclave were injured this week

Incidents

- The Abdul-aziz/Karaan grouping found 13 AK 47 bullets this week
- The Bondhere/Shibis grouping unearthed 2 big rusted 120 mm mortar shells
- In the Deynile/Wardhigley grouping found 4 rusted anti-aircraft shells from a *Zoo*
- The Dharkeynley/Wadajir grouping found a total of 15 bullets for an AK 47 and 2 RPG rounds
- The Hawl-wadag/Hodan grouping found 2 anti-tank shells and 2 hand grenades
- The Heliwaa/Yaqshid grouping unearthed 3 bazooka shells
- The workers of the Bermuda enclave found 17 bullets of various types, including G3, AK 47, MG and SAR 80 – as well as 2 RPG rockets
- The truck owners continue to encounter difficulties because of the ever increasing number of roadblocks forcibly extorting money. The trucks are countering by trying to use side roads. The majority of the trucks dump the collected waste in Keysaney dumpsite because of the increasing insecurity.
- On one occasion, a district police officer ordered the trucks to go back to the worksites as they heading towards the dumpsite of Keysaney. The workers suspect that the police officer was too officious and was intending to impose his authority on SAACID. Ms. Hawa, the Deputy Country Director of SAACID, contacted the District Commissioner (DC) of Karaan, raising the incident with him. The police later requested that SAACID clearly identify the trucks working on the road and hauling the garbage for security reasons. This was done long ago; and it appears like it was an amateurish attempt to extort money.

- 12 people from the Abdul-aziz/Karaan grouping were injured this week
- 3 people from the Bondhere/Shibis grouping were injured this week
- 15 people from the Deynile/Wardhigley grouping were injured this week

- 10 people from the Shingani/Hamar-weyne grouping were injured this week
- 11 people from the Hawl-wadag/Hodan grouping were injured this week

- The Dharkeynley/Wadajir grouping found 2 rocket propelled antitank missiles
- The Shingani/Hamar-weyne grouping found rusted AK bullets and 3 RPG rockets
- The Hawl-wadag/Hodan grouping found 4 rusted anti-aircraft shells
- The Heliwaa/Yaqshid grouping unearthed 6 rifle bullets
- The Warberi/Hamar-jajab grouping found 3 120 mm mortar shells
- The Warberi/Hamar-jajab grouping killed a big cobra-like snake
- The workers of the Bermuda enclave found 12 bullets of various types
